CALL FOR CONTRIBUTORS FOR AN INTERNATIONAL EXHIBITION ON PLASTIC POLLUTION

PLASTIC ODYSSEY OFFERS YOUNG PEOPLE AROUND THE MEDITERRANEAN TO CONTRIBUTE TO AN INTERNATIONAL EXHIBITION ON PLASTIC POLLUTION, BY BEARING WITNESS TO THE PLASTIC POLLUTION IN THEIR REGION. THE YOUNG PEOPLE'S PRODUCTIONS WILL BE EXHIBITED AND TRAVEL AROUND THE WORLD FOR 3 YEARS.

PLASTIC ODYSSEY

Plastic Odyssey is a global initiative to fight plastic pollution in the ocean.

At the end of 2022, Plastic Odyssey will launch a 3-year round-the-world expedition aboard a ship with 20 explorers (sailors, engineers, mediators, human and social science researchers, etc.). These explorers will stop over in 30 countries, and their mission will be to find solutions to put an end to plastic pollution in the ocean.

For this expedition, Plastic Odyssey is preparing a travelling exhibition on plastic pollution: the Explorabox. It will travel from city to city on 3 continents. It will bear witness to the impact of plastic pollution around the world, highlight the women and men who are mobilising everywhere on our planet, and invite the public to explore new avenues. It will be made entirely from recycled plastics and natural materials, and will welcome the public free of charge at each stage of the expedition.

HOW TO TAKE PART

- > This challenge is open to young people aged living in France, Lebanon, Egypt, Tunisia, Morocco and Algeria.
- > You can submit an individual contribution, or group contribution (as a class for example).

Choose between 3 topics :

PLASTIC EVERYWHERE EVERYTHING PLASTIC

Where is plastic used, in what context, for what purpose? What are the most commonly used plastic objects in your country, region or city? What are they used for, who uses them, who sells them, who makes them?

BEHIND THE WASTE, WOMEN AND MEN

What happens to our plastic objects once we have finished using them? Where do they go? Who collects the plastic, recycles it, or unwittingly inherits it?

THE ALTERNATIVES TO PLASTIC IN MY COUNTRY

Are there alternatives to plastic that are used in my country ? What are they? How did we live before plastic appeared?
