

Plastic Odyssey: A Major Stopover in the Philippines to Combat Plastic Pollution



Plastic Odyssey, the pioneering maritime expedition dedicated to reducing plastic pollution worldwide, is making a significant stopover in the Philippines. From November 18 to 28, the expedition will dock in Manila before continuing to Cebu from December 2 to 14. This stopover is one of the expedition's most ambitious phases in Asia, featuring initiatives to support sustainable development and engage local communities.

INNOVATIVE SOLUTIONS: TWO MICRO-FACTORIES DELIVERED

Plastic Odyssey's Philippines stopover is marked by the construction and delivery of two microfactories, one in Manila and the other in Cebu, created in partnership with **DELFINGEN Foundation**. These micro-factories will be handed over between late November and early December. Designed to transform plastic waste into valuable materials, they represent a replicable and cost-effective model to empower communities to tackle plastic pollution locally.

EMPOWERING THE NEXT GENERATION: YOUTH FOR DAGAT

Another highlight of this stopover is the launch of the **«Youth for Dagat»** (Youth for the Ocean) program. This initiative, co-led by **Plastic Odyssey**, the **French Embassy in the Philippines** and **FPUA**, focuses on raising environmental awareness among young people. Through educational activities, ship tours, and workshops, the program inspires and equips the next generation to become stewards of the environment.







A PACKED CALENDAR OF EVENTS

Manila's stopover offers a variety of public and private events to engage diverse audiences:

- November 19: Opening event and launch of the «Youth for Dagat» program at Alliance Française de Manille (5 PM), followed by documentary screening (8 PM).
- November 20, 21, 22: Incubation program «Onboard Laboratory» for entrepreneurs and project owners to discover onboard all recycling innovation documented by Plastic Odyssey during the first 2 years of expedition.
- November 22, 25, 26, 28: School tours for «Youth for Dagat», emphasizing education and innovation, raising awereness about plastic pollution and existing solutions.
- November 27: Inauguration of the Recycling Micro-Factory, nearby the Plastic Odyssey vessel at Cruise Terminal Eva Macapagal.

Cebu will host similar activities, continuing the mission to create awareness and provide practical solutions to plastic waste.
